Main data disclosed in the work report of Guiyang Municipal Government

Guiyang Mayor Chen Yan made a government work report at the Sixth Session of the Fourteenth Guiyang Municipal People's Congress on February 25. He reviewed the municipal government's work in 2020 and the 13th Five-Year Plan period, and put forward the main objectives and tasks for the 14th Five-Year Plan period and the long-term goals for 2035. Let's take a look at the historic achievements and changes of Guiyang through a set of data.



431.17 billion

Economic strength rose sharply. The gross domestic product (GDP) of Guiyang reached 431.17 billion yuan, spanning two hundred-billion steps in five years, with an average annual economic growth rate of 9%, the highest in all provincial capital cities. The per capita GDP exceeded 12,000 US dollars.

4.1:36:59.9

Quality and efficiency were steadily improved. The ratio of primary, secondary and tertiary industries was adjusted to 4.1:36:59.9. The added value of high-tech manufacturing enterprises increased to 18.9% of that of industrial enterprises above designated size, and the proportion of new economy and green economy in GDP increased to 24% and 46% respectively.

43,000

The decisive battle against poverty was a complete victory. 43,000 rural poor people were lifted out of poverty according to the current standards, 12,000 poor people moved out of the mountains through relocation for poverty alleviation, and 520,000 rural residents had access to clean drinking water.

40,305 yuan; 18,674 yuan

People lived a happier life. The per capita disposable income of urban and rural residents reached 40,305 yuan and 18,674 yuan, up 13,064 yuan and 6,756 yuan over 2015, registering an average annual growth rate of 8.2% and 9.4% respectively.

A review of key work in 2020

In 2020, Guiyang took measures to respond to Covid-19 and advance economic and social development. The GDP of Guiyang increased by 5%, the highest in the province and one of the highest in all provincial capitals. Remarkable achievements were made mainly in the following areas.

Guiyang-Gui'an Integration

Guiyang-Gui'an Integrated Development Plan (2020-2025) was formulated. The development of six new industries in Guiyang and five key industries in Gui'an New Area was accelerated. The construction of major projects such as Hengli (Guiyang) Industrial Park was started. Smooth progress was seen in the construction of Gui'an-Suzhou Industrial Park. Two cities jointly built a green financial reform and innovation pilot zone, with a balance of green loans of 181.74 billion yuan.

People's livelihood

138,900 new urban jobs were created, and the registered urban unemployment rate was 4.04%. Temporary subsidies of 200 million yuan were distributed to low-income residents in financial distress and

unemployment insurance benefits of 584 million yuan were provided to 115,000 unemployed people. A total of 819 million yuan was used to ensure people's basic livelihood and the operation of grass-roots governments.

Economy

The aid to enterprises witnessed remarkable results, with tax and fee reduction and exemption of 24.87 billion yuan and temporary social security fee reduction and exemption of 5.34 billion yuan. A series of measures were launched to support enterprises, helping industrial enterprises to obtain working capital loans of 2.73 billion yuan, and small and medium-sized enterprises to obtain emergency funds of 873 million yuan through refinancing. Construction of 138 new industrial projects was kicked

off, and industrial investment increased by 3.8%. 102 industrial projects were put into operation, 115 industrial enterprises above designated size were added, and the added value of industrial enterprises above designated size increased by 6.1%, the highest rate in the province. The construction of 5G networks and Internet of Things was sped up, and investment in fixed assets increased by 2.7%. Total retail sales of consumer goods reached 218.8 billion yuan, an increase of 6.6%.

Review of work during the "Thirteenth Five-Year Plan" Period

The "Thirteenth Five-Year Plan" period was one of the periods in which the quality of economic and social development in Guiyang was the highest, the urban and rural landscape changed the most, and the people had the strongest sense of gain. In this period, the following work was accomplished.

Poverty alleviation

A total of **1.83** billion yuan was invested and **458** assistance projects were implemented, helping **510,000** poor people in **13** poverty-stricken counties in the province get rid of poverty.



² Big data technology



- The Guiyang-Gui'an international Internet data dedicated channel was built, with a provincial outbound bandwidth of 17.000G.
- There were 117 big data enterprises above designated size. The operating income of electronic information manufacturing and software & IT service companies above designated size reached 10.3 billion yuan and 20.29 billion yuan respectively, and the total operating income of telecommunications business hit 87.31 billion yuan.
- The proportion of industrial enterprises above designated size using cloud computing technology exceeded 85%.

Environmental actions

- More than 99% of urban domestic garbage was treated harmlessly.
- 98.5% of urban domestic sewage was treated.
- 98% of the city's public buses were powered by new and clean energy.



• More than 98% of industrial solid waste was treated for reuse.

Supply-side structural reform

• 679 "thousand-enterprise transformation" projects were implemented; the comprehensive index of industrializationinformatization integration was raised to 53.2; 801 industrial enterprises were above designated size.



- The balance of RMB deposits and loans of financial institutions reached
 1.25 trillion yuan and 1.58 trillion yuan respectively.
- The added value of modern service industry accounted for 53% of that of the entire service industry, and Guiyang became one of the first pilot cities of national culture and tourism consumption.
- More than 65% of the city's economic growth was contributed by scientific and technological progress. With an innovation index of 55.8, Guiyang ranked 24th among the 12 innovative cities evaluated nationwide.

New urbanization

- Urban roads exceeded 2,100 kilometers in total length.
- Rail transit Line 1 was put into operation and Line 2 into trial operation.
- 43 commercial complexes were built.
- 543 urban and rural outlets of supply and marketing cooperatives were newly built.
- 317 beautiful countryside demonstration villages and 4 national key villages for rural tourism were added.

Reforms in key areas

- 100% government services were accessible online in a one-stop manner. The time limit for examining and approving business registration, real estate registration and project construction was shortened to one, five and eighty working days respectively, and Guiyang became one of the pilot cities in China for the reform of simplified deregistration of businesses.
- The policy of tax and fee reduction was strictly implemented, waiving 100.31 billion yuan in taxes and fees in total.

High-level opening-up

- Guiyang Longdongbao International Airport opened 254 air routes, handling over 21 million passengers annually.
- 75 Fortune-500 domestic and foreign enterprises and 4,583 industrial projects were introduced. Funds of 512.4 billion yuan were put in place, with an average annual growth rate of 15.2%.



• China (Guiyang) Cross-border Electronic Ecommerce Comprehensive Experimental Zone was established, becoming a pilot project for comprehensive promotion of service trade innovation and development; Guiyang became a member city of United Cities and Local Governments (UCLG).



Guiyang had 17 international friendly cities and traded with 191 countries and regions. The number of foreign-funded enterprises increased to 432, and total foreign trade volume reached US\$ 20.68 billion, actually utilizing foreign capital of US\$ 7.83 billion.

Progress in social programs

- A total of **339,800** people received vocational skills training.
- A total of **99,700** primary and secondary school places were newly added.
- Medical care was more inclusive, and social insurance for urban and rural residents covered all those eligible.



- Guiyang became a model city of the national public cultural service system.
- The per capita area for sports reached **1.99** square meters.
- 99.38% of residents had a sense of security.

Main objectives and key tasks for the "14th Five-Year Plan" Period

Main objectives of economic and social development

- Guiyang's gross domestic product (GDP) grows by more than 8% annually, with per capita GDP reaching more than 100,000 yuan.
- The increase of per capita disposable income of urban and rural residents is basically synchronized with economic growth.
- The added value of manufacturing industry accounts for more than 25% of GDP, and the proportion of private investment in fixed assets investment stays at about 60%.
- Guiyang's primacy as a provincial capital will be further strengthened.

Key tasks

- Adhere to innovation-driven development and build an innovative central city
 - Guiyang will strengthen IPR protection and enhance the ability of scientific and technological innovation.





• The R&D funds of the whole society will account for more than **2.6%** of GDP. The big data and real economy integration index will reach 60.

The construction of new infrastructure will be vigorously promoted to form three hundred-billion-yuan-level industrial clusters comprising data centers, electronic information manufacturing enterprises, software & IT service companies. By 2025, the added value of digital economy will account for more than 45% of GDP.



- Adhere to coordinated development, promote the integrated development of Guiyang and Gui'an, and build a city with a large economic scale
 - By 2025, the urban built-up area will reach more than 600 square kilometers, and the permanent resident population will reach about 6.3 million, 80% of whom will have Guiyang hukou.



- Focusing on the real economy, the city will further promote new industrialization and the high-quality development of the manufacturing industry. By 2025, industrial added value will account for more than 25% of GDP.
- Adhere to green development, push forward the green transformation of economic and social development, and build an eco-friendly city



- Vigorous efforts will be made to build a sponge city, the forest coverage rate reach 55% at least, more than 95% of days of the year will have a good air quality, and the water quality of 100% centralized drinking water
- The environmental industry will be vigorously promoted, and an action plan will be formulated and implemented to ensure that carbon emissions will peak before 2030.
- Further efforts will be made to re-utilize industrial solid wastes as resources. Domestic waste classification and recycling will be comprehensively promoted



Adhere to open development, promote high-4 level opening up and build a high-quality inland open city

- Guiyang will seize the opportunity of building a new land-sea channel in western China, actively integrate into national development strategies such as the "Belt and Road Initiative", strengthen cooperation with the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area and other regions, continuously broaden the open channels to the outside world, and speed up the construction of a national logistics hub.
- The city will strengthen the functions of Gui'an New Area and the "5+6" platform for opening to the outside world, and build a nationallevel foreign trade transformation and upgrading base. A marketoriented, law-based international business environment will be created.



• By 2025, the city's total foreign trade volume will reach 12 billion US dollars, actual utilization of foreign capital will exceed 5 billion US dollars, and funds in place for newly introduced projects will reach 283 billion yuan.

Adhere to shared development, improve people's livelihood, and build a shared and jointly governed city

 All-round efforts will be made to implement the rural revitalization strategy, consolidate and expand



the achievements of poverty alleviation, deepen the rural industrial revolution, and speed up the construction of a modern agricultural management system.



- Investment in people's livelihood will be increased to promote the balanced development of public services such as education, social security, medical care and old-age care.
- The prosperity and development of cultural undertakings and cultural industries will be promoted to enhance the city's cultural strength and influence.



Main objectives and key tasks for 2021

Main economic and social development goals

Gross domestic product (GDP) increases by more than 9%, general public budget revenue by 2%, investment in fixed assets by 8%, total retail sales of consumer goods by 9%, per capita disposable income of urban and rural residents by 8% and 9% respectively, and the balance of RMB deposits and loans of financial institutions by 10% and 15% respectively. The output value of green economy and that of digital economy account for 47% and 39% of GDP. The increase of consumer price is kept within the range set by the provincial government.

Key tasks

Digital economy

- Work will be done to cultivate 50 big data-supported demonstration enterprises, build more than five billion-yuan-level big data industry agglomeration demonstration bases.
- ◆ Increase the digital economy's added value to 180 billion yuan.
- ◆ Implement more than 300 comprehensive and integrated big data application projects, and build more than 5,000 new 5G base stations.



Integrated development

- The general and special land and space plans of Guiyang and Gui'an will be formulated.
- ◆ Rail transit Line 2, the southwest ring line of urban express railway, and Gui'an high-speed railway station will be put into operation. Four urban trunk roads, including the Taijin Road, will be built to link Guiyang and Gui'an.





- Intelligent terminal manufacturing, software and IT service industries will be developed vigorously.
- ◆ The integration of land, technology, labor will be promoted.

Real economy

Efforts will be made to promote the transformation and upgrading of traditional industries such as phosphorus chemical, aluminum smelting, and aluminum processing industries, accelerate the development of leading industries such as electronic information manufacturing and advanced equipment manufacturing.



 Build 150 new industrial and 150 new service enterprises above designated size, cultivate or build a digital service export base and three key export enterprises.



- ◆ The amount of service outsourcing contracts fulfilled will increase by 12%.
- ◆ The tourism industry will be greatly promoted through the integration and development of "tourism+" and "+tourism" industries.

Investment and consumption

- ◆ Investment in strategic emerging industries, environmental protection, people's livelihood and other fields will be increased.
- ◆ 707 provincial major and key projects will be implemented, with an annual investment of more than 150 billion yuan.
- ◆ Industrial investments will account for more than 30% of fixed assets investments, and total retail sales of consumer goods will exceed 230 billion yuan.

Rural revitalization

 Famous agricultural produce processing and logistics enterprises will be introduced or cultivated.





◆ The total output value of agricultural produce processing enterprises above designated size will reach 65 billion yuan at least, and 58% of farm produce will be processed into food products.

Opening-up

- ◆ Phase-III project of the Guiyang Longdongbao International Airport will be completed.
- Bonded logistics, warehousing and processing of imported bulk agricultural products will be developed.



- ◆ A good job will be done in preparing for and organizing major events such as China International Big Data Industry Expo 2021 and Eco Forum Global Annual Conference Guiyang 2021.
- ◆ The city will cultivate 65 foreign trade enterprises with annual sales above 10 million US dollars, and introduce 900 new industrial projects with an actual in-place capital of 162 billion yuan, an increase of 13%. Specifically, the capital in place for industrial projects will account for more than 50% of the total, and the actual utilization of foreign capital will be 2.2 billion US dollars, an increase of 10%.

Environmental protection

- ◆ More than 98.5% of urban domestic sewage will be treated.
- ◆ Classified garbage cans for municipal solid waste will be made available throughout the city, 100% of classified collection and transportation facilities will meet the national standard, and 35% of municipal waste will be recycled.
- ◆ 13,340 hectares of land will afforested and one million square meters of new urban green space will be added.

30,000 primary and secondary school spaces.



1,000 high-quality beds in tertiary public hospitals.



10,000 affordable housing units will be provided.
