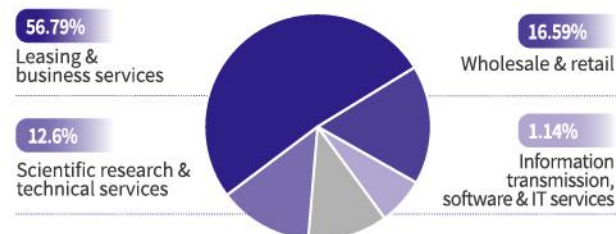


Major sources of foreign investment



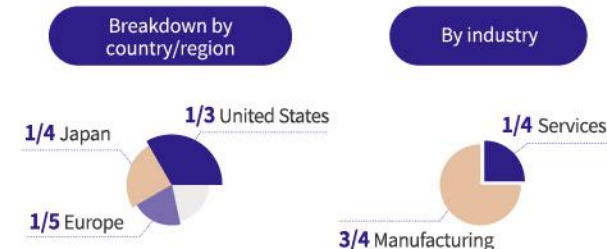
Foreign investment by industry

In 2025, the services sector accounted for **98.52%** of Pudong's paid-in FDI. This was heavily led by four key industries, which together contributed **87.12%** of the sector's total.

As a highly competitive global hub for corporate headquarters, Pudong hosts **500** regional headquarters of multinational corporations (MNCs), accounting for **46.5%** of the city's total.

Pudong is actively developing the Silk Road E-commerce pilot cooperation zone, and partnering with global e-commerce platforms such as Temu, eBay, and Alibaba to expand its cross-border e-commerce business. 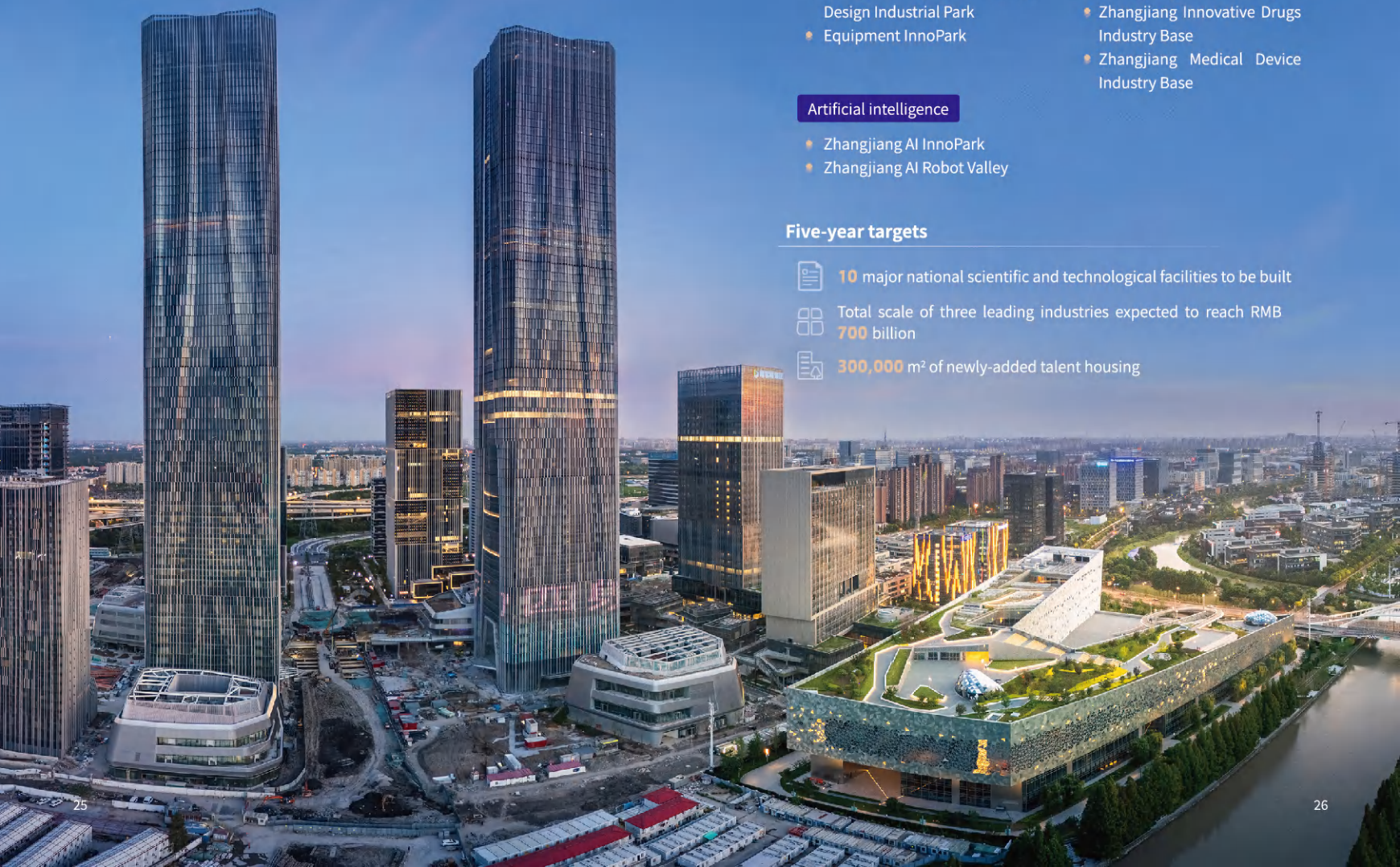

Core Area

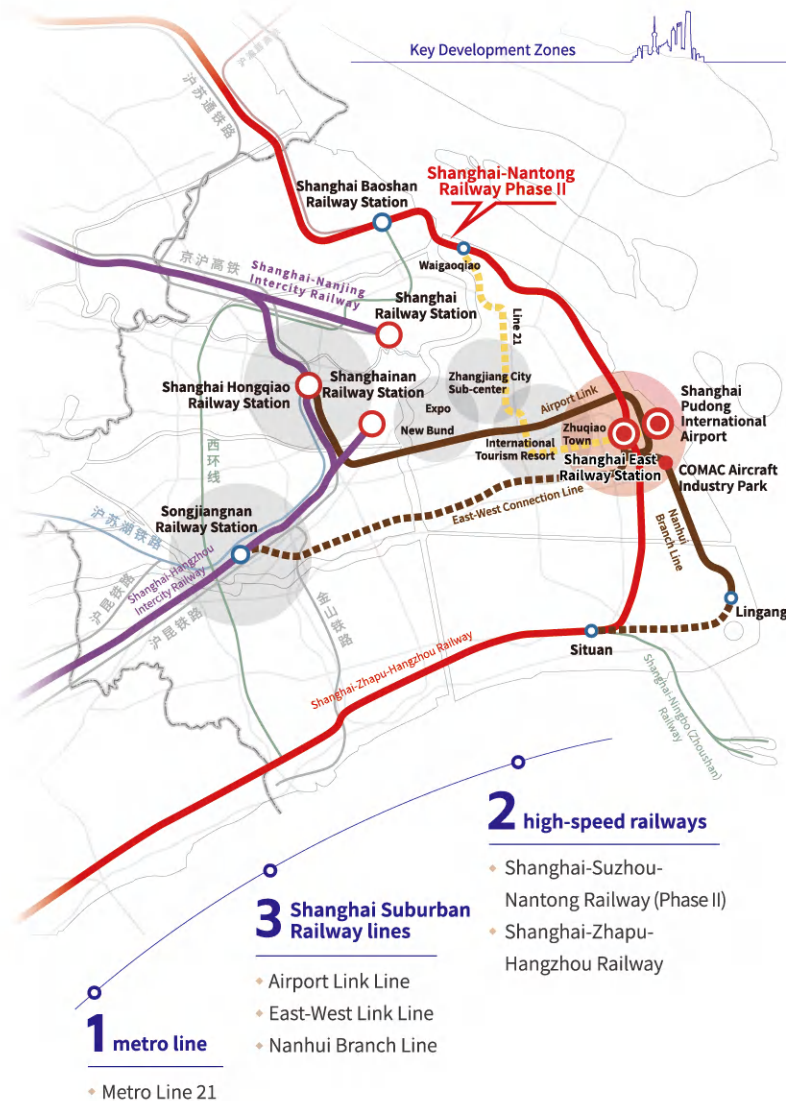
Building on the management regimes for comprehensive bonded zones, areas under customs supervision, and port-restricted areas, the IB CZ introduces policies that facilitate cross-border movement of personnel, alongside business services within a designated controlled area. This extends the “freer access at the first line, and effective control at the second line” model from goods to people

3 major functions

- ◆ International business exchanges
- ◆ Exhibitions
- ◆ Training

Efficient and facilitative measures

- ◆ **Facilitated entry and exit of personnel:** International visitors with a registered invitation may enter the IB CZ visa-free for up to 30 days, with options to extend. They may also benefit from port visa policies and visa-free transit arrangements. Domestic personnel can enter the IB CZ with an access permit
- ◆ **Streamlined baggage management:** The IB CZ provides convenience for visitors’ baggage intended for personal and reasonable use by allowing advance customs declaration, tax refund, and baggage check-in prior to departure from the IB CZ
- ◆ **Efficient goods management:** The flow of goods in and out of the IB CZ is managed in accordance with the policies for comprehensive bonded zones. Goods procured within China but outside the IB CZ may enter the IB CZ upon registration at customs checkpoints. Imported supplies and equipment required for the construction and operations of the IB CZ are subject to catalogue-based management and are exempt from import duties, value-added tax, and consumption tax



Shanghai East Railway Station

Air-rail connectivity

Offering seamless transfers to Shanghai Pudong International Airport, national rail services, the Airport Link Line, and Shanghai Metro, the Shanghai East Railway Station further integrates Shanghai into the Yangtze River Delta and the broader global network

Investment Safeguards

Legal Safeguards

Authorized by the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress and the Standing Committee of the Shanghai Municipal People's Congress with local legislative rights, Shanghai Municipality and Pudong New Area have enacted **61** local regulations and administrative measures for Pudong New Area

A total of **24** Pudong New Area regulations have been promulgated in areas including market access and exit, IP protection, financial services, industrial development promotion, and commercial mediation. Another **37** administrative measures have been issued to support developments in areas such as warehouse receipt registration, legal services, fair competition review, trade secret protection, and diversified mechanisms for resolving foreign-related commercial disputes



IP protection

● China (Pudong) Intellectual Property Protection Center

The Center has shortened the turnaround time for patent applications to **3 months** for invention patents, **1 month** for utility model patents, and as fast as **1 week** for design patents

● China (Shanghai) Pilot Free Trade Zone Copyright Service Center

The Center enables expedited copyright registration with a processing time of **five** working days. It is also pioneering a cross-regional registration scheme, which allows non-Shanghai residents to complete copyright registration where the copyright-related acts occur

● National Platform (Shanghai) for International Service of Intellectual Property Operation

The Platform provides services in IP transactions, innovative financing, overseas development and rights protection, as well as support for key industry operations and essential services



Talent Services

- ◆ Pudong rolled out 15 measures to support young innovators and entrepreneurs, including the provision of 1 million m² of low-rent apartments and another 1 million m² of subsidized office space for startups
- ◆ Pudong has been authorized to issue the Confirmation Letter for Foreign High-End Talent, enabling streamlined procedures for work permits, entry-exit, and residence permits for foreign professionals
- ◆ With a recommendation, top foreign professionals working in Pudong can apply for permanent residence. Their foreign spouses and dependent children may apply together with them
- ◆ Pudong released a list of recognized overseas professional qualifications (149 in total) and another list of in-demand qualifications (23 in total), and issued the Notice on Providing Facilitated Services for Holders of Recognized Overseas Professional Qualifications. A dedicated platform has been established to support the application of the list of recognized overseas professional qualifications
- ◆ Pudong is piloting measures to facilitate currency conversion and remittance of salary income for foreign talent. Through the Fast Pass for Foreign Talent Salary Exchange and Remittance, foreign professionals can enjoy installment-based, interbank salary remittance services with no additional paperwork requirements
- ◆ Pudong's innovative service package offers foreign talent holistic support across six areas: immigration consulting, social integration, residence and mobility, legal assistance, family support, and language and cultural services
- ◆ Foreign nationals travelling to China on short notice for business, investment, or exchange activities can apply for port visas or port e-visas for entry
- ◆ Pudong is expanding the reach of its International Talent Station, making it an ideal first stop for highly skilled, promising young talent seeking a job or starting a business
- ◆ Pudong launched a series of talent outreach programs for outstanding college students across the globe, connecting them to potential internship or job opportunities

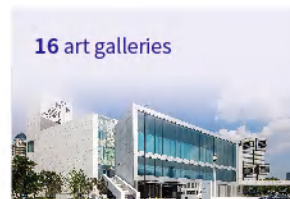

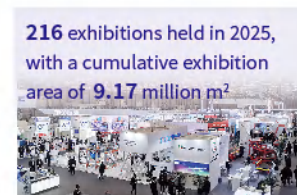

Investor Support Channels

Shanghai Pudong New Area Foreign Investment and Trade Promotion Center

As an affiliated public institution under the Pudong New Area Commission of Commerce, the Center is responsible for foreign investment promotion and enterprise services, as well as supporting domestic enterprises in expanding overseas. It facilitates both FDI inflows and outbound investment by Chinese enterprises through a range of activities, including investment promotion, business services, outreach, and policy briefings. Delegated by the Pudong New Area Commission of Commerce, the Center conducts the preliminary review and accreditation of regional headquarters of MNCs and foreign-invested R&D centers, as well as the receipt and review of applications for municipal-level headquarters development funding

Shanghai Pudong Headquarters Economy Shared Service Center (Platform)

Pudong New Area has pioneered a China-first model of integrated government services for market entities. Led by Pudong New Area Commission of Commerce and in collaboration with the Pudong New Area Association of Enterprises with Foreign Investment, the Platform integrates government and social resources to deliver comprehensive, professional, and tailored services. To date, it has served over 1,000 headquarters of various types

Pudong New Area Complaint Center for Foreign-Invested Enterprises

Pudong established the Complaint Center in 2021 and issued the Measures for Handling Complaints of Foreign-Invested Enterprises in Pudong New Area to protect the legitimate rights and interests of foreign-invested enterprises in Pudong and ensure a stable and predictable investment environment
