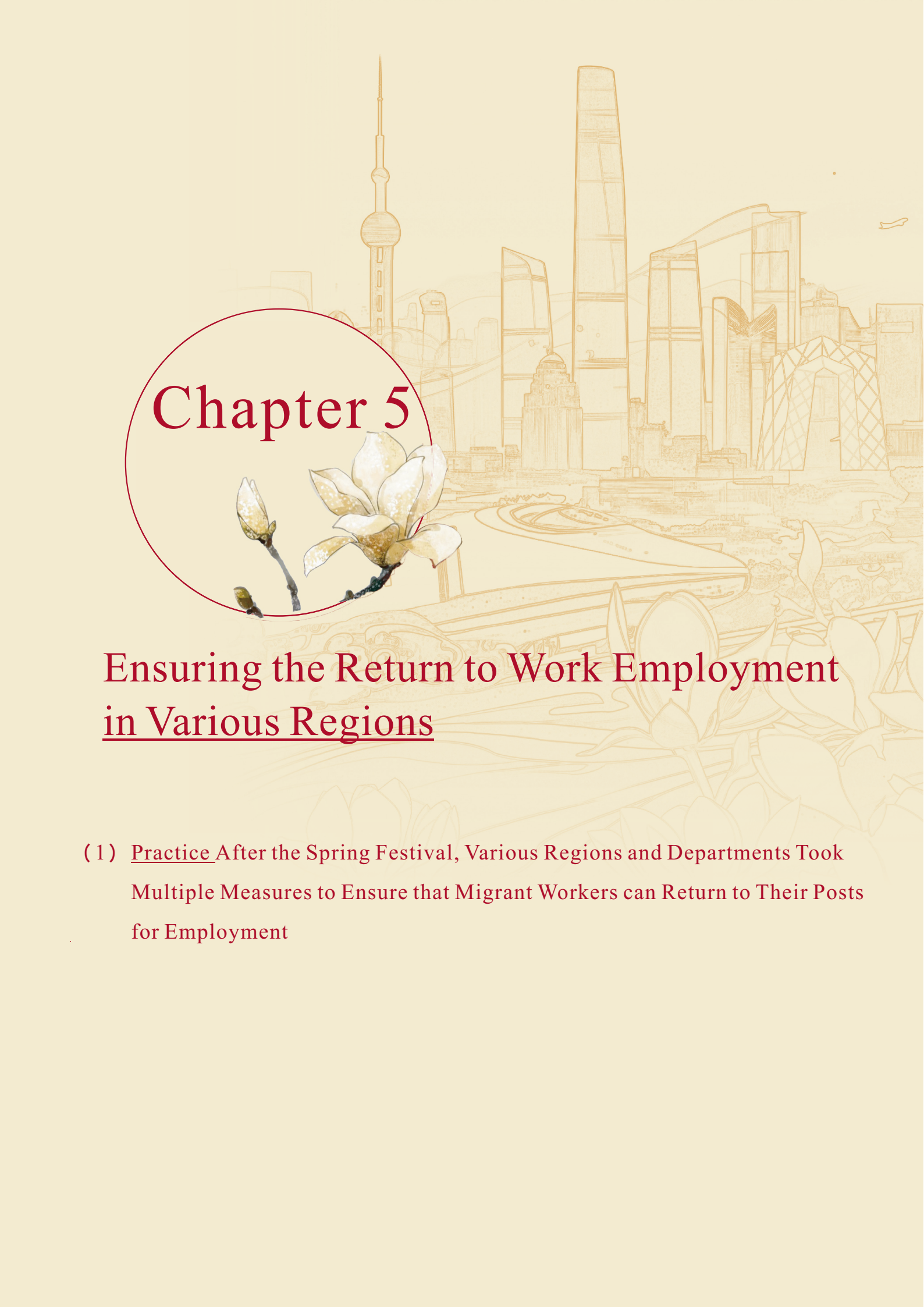

(1) Practice After the Spring Festival, Various Regions and Departments Took Multiple Measures to Ensure that Migrant Workers can Return to Their Posts for Employment¹⁸

After the end of the 2025 Chinese Spring Festival holiday, the country ushered in a peak of migrant workers returning to work. All regions and departments, through a series of powerful, warm, and precise measures such as “point-to-point” special trains, chartered flights, skills training, and recruitment activities, fully ensured the smooth return of migrant workers and helped enterprises resume work and production.

In order to alleviate the transportation difficulties of migrant workers returning to work, many places have opened free “point-to-point” return special trains and chartered flights to achieve seamless connection from “doorstep” to “factory door.” For example, Guizhou opened 19 special return trains and handled more than 10,000 return tickets. Guangxi plans to operate more than 1,000 return train services in the first quarter, serving over 1 million people. Dingxi City, Gansu Province, organized high-speed rail special trains to provide free transportation services for more than 530 migrant workers, arranging staff to escort them throughout the journey to ensure that

migrant workers safely reach their destinations. In addition, Fuzhou City, Fujian Province, brought back 365 Yunnan migrant workers through chartered flights, providing labor security for the timely resumption of work for enterprises.

Before the Spring Festival, all regions strengthened dynamic monitoring of returning workers, established a list of returning personnel and external employment needs, and carried out targeted skills training and recruitment activities. Pu'an County, Guizhou Province, organized 13,500 people to go out for employment through skills training and recruitment activities, driving 82,500 employment opportunities. Lianyungang, Jiangsu Province, offered more than 200 job openings at one time, and enterprises in Pingxiang, Jiangxi Province, also arranged special skills training for job seekers to help them get employed quickly. Zhejiang, Hubei and other provinces plan to hold thousands of recruitment activities, providing nearly one million job positions to accurately meet employment needs.

Various regions also enhanced migrant workers' sense of gain and

happiness through policy subsidies and heart-warming services. Weining City, Guizhou Province, issued travel subsidies (referred to as “self-driving return red envelopes”), and Putian City gave one-time stable employment bonuses to enterprises with stable employee teams. In addition, Guangxi, Guizhou, and other areas provided employment guidance and job matching services on the return trains, and distributed care packages so that migrant workers could feel the support of their “own family”.

The guarantee of migrant workers

returning to work after the Spring Festival not only reflects the high attention paid by local governments to people's livelihood issues but also injects strong impetus into the resumption of work and production of enterprises and economic recovery. Through “point-to-point” services, skills training, policy support and other multiple measures, all regions are taking practical actions to help migrant workers realize their dreams and lay a solid foundation for achieving “stable employment” and a “good start.”
